DISCUSSION GUIDE

Joshua faces a unique challenge when the battle lines are drawn and a former enemy is now an ally. Because of the Gibeonites' deception in chapter 9, the Israelites are called on to honor their oath and stand with them against the five Amorite kings. This would be like an Arab nation in the Middle East deciding they no longer want to be a Muslim nation and would rather side with the United States. It was a big deal.

Not only are the Israelites fighting five armies at once, they're fighting on behalf of a former enemy who deceived them into an alliance. Do you think Joshua believed in a God who was big enough to do all he asked and then some? Joshua had to trust God to take care of the details, then it was up to him to believe and move forward in faith. Joshua was bold enough to ask for the sun to stand still so he could defeat the enemies of God.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What stood out to you from Sunday's message?
2. On a scale from 1–10 (smallest to largest), how big are your prayers?
3. Can you identify why your prayers are the "size" they are?
4. How are you trusting God for the details of your prayers and/or dreams?
5. What are you doing right now that fulfills the statement "Being faithful where I am"?
6. Do you have any unanswered prayers that are weighing your heart down? What prayerful dreams and desires seem unattainable to you?
7. If God were to answer your prayer tomorrow, are you prepared for whatever changes it would bring? How will you move forward in faith today to prepare?
