Key Scriptures: Psalm 139

DISCUSSION GUIDE

This Sunday is the 5th week of the God is... series. Remember, the idea is that you can only love someone to the extent that you know someone. Now that you've gotten to know God as Creator, Justice and Mercy, Trinity, that He is good, and as Omni, hopefully you've fallen more in love with Him. And because of that, you are worshipping Him from a deep well of awe and living your life to honor Him. This week, we learned that omni means all. We see that God is omnipresent—which means He's everywhere; God is omniscience—all knowing; and God is omnipotent—all powerful. What's more—there is NO other god who is ever given these attributes. The One True God is the only One who is omni. And because he is everywhere, all knowing, and all powerful, we can trust Him with our everything. The God who **is** all can be trusted **in** all.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Think back to Sunday's message. What do you remember? Review your notes if you have them. If you're with a life group, talk with them about anything you found memorable or confusing.
2. Read all of Psalm 139 aloud. How are omnipresence, omniscience, and omnipotence connected? (hint: 1st 6 verses=omniscience; 2nd 6 verses = omnipresence; 3rd 6 verses = omnipotent)
3. Read Psalm 139:7-12 aloud and consider the specific descriptions David gives. How do they make his point that it is impossible to get away from God?
4. What do the following passages say about the doctrine of divine omnipresence? a. 1 Kings 8:27 b. Isaiah 66:1-2 c. Acts 7:48
5. Read 1 John 3:20. How does God's omniscience bring relief to Christians in difficult circumstances? Does the fact that He knows everything provide comfort by itself, or does comfort come from considering His knowledge together with other attributes?
6. Pastor Neal shared four things believers can do because of God's omnipotence. Which of them stood out to you? (1 Cor. 10:13, 1 John 4:4, Romans 8:11, Acts 1:8)
7. How might our lives be different if we really believed God was omnipotent, omniscient and omnipresent?
8. What's one thing you learned from Sunday's message and today's discussion that will help you become a better disciple of Christ, and help others do the same?
