DEPARTURE

Check-in | 7 a.m. | Wednesday, June 18 | Cedar Valley North Lobby

Please arrive on time. Parents are welcome to stay until the buses leave, but it isn't required. Kids should eat breakfast before arriving.

RETURN

Pick-up | 1:30 p.m. | Saturday, June 21 | Cedar Valley North Lobby

This is our projected arrival time, but it may be adjusted due to traffic, weather, and unforeseen circumstances. **NOTE:** The trailer with luggage should return before the bus for parents to retrieve luggage before kids arrive.

LODGING

SPENDING MONEY/OFFERING

Kids have the option to give toward the daily Boys and Girls Missionary Challenge (BGMC) offering and purchase small items/snacks at the camp store. Parents can send spending money in small bills. If sending money, put it in a zip lock bag labeled with your child's first and last name and drop off at check-in.

MEDICATIONS

All medication, including non-prescription drugs, MUST be turned in at check-in on Wednesday, with a completed camper medication form. Medications must be in the original container or packaging clearly marked with your child's name. Medication will not be accepted loose in a bag or in a pill dispenser. The name of the camper **MUST** be on prescription medications. Acetaminophen, ibuprofen, aspirin, cough suppressant, antacid, hydrocortisone ointment, decongestant, antibiotic ointment, and antihistamine are available in the nurse's office at camp and do not need to be sent with your child. Please don't send vitamins.
